

Product Smooths Wrinkles Without Collagen, Botox

Results Last Longer Than Collagen

ORLANDO, Fla. -- A new product is reportedly filling in the lines and wrinkles on patient's faces without the use of Botox or collagen, according to Local 6 News.



The report featured Nedra Maxwell, 47, who went to Dr. Roger Bassin for a product called Restylane.

Restylane is a crystal-clear, non-animal, biodegradable gel based on a natural substance, called hyaluronic acid. The gel is injected into the skin in tiny amounts with a very fine needle.

The product provides fullness to the skin and reportedly lasts longer than collagen. While collagen only lasts about three months, the effects of Restylane can last up to a year. Local 6 News also reported that Botox is often used on the forehead but should never be used below the eyes because it would cause your face to droop.

The Restylane product works under the eyes and on lips and costs about \$500, according to the report.

Restylane was recently approved by the Food and Drug Administration.
